## Course Description:

This course is a foundation course that builds on the skills developed in 10F and 11G. The purpose of the course is to continue to develop the skills of the six strands of English Language Arts that are: reading, listening, viewing, writing, speaking and presenting. The foundation focus asks students to read and compose 50% pragmatic (practical) and 50% aesthetic (artistic) text.

## Evaluation:

The types of activities required for assessment will be varied and will reflect the demands of the curriculum and the special needs of the students in the classroom. The major focus of the evaluation tasks will be critical reading, process writing and demand writing.
