

ROLLING RIVER SCHOOL DIVISION POLICY

Student Transportation for Program Not Offered

EAAAB/P

A) Programs Not Offered in Rolling River School Division

In lieu of school bus transportation, a student who is resident in the Rolling River School Division and who is approved to enroll and attend school in another School Division because he/she is enrolled in a program of study that is not offered in the Rolling River School Division, may be paid a mileage allowance equivalent to the annual transportation grant paid by Manitoba Education.

The allowance will be pro-rated to a monthly fee to be paid on a monthly basis subject to the following conditions:

- the student continues to reside in the Rolling River School Division,
- the program is a public school program recognized by Manitoba Education and is not offered in the Rolling River School Division,
- the student attends over 50% of the recognized program courses each month, and
- the student does not receive school bus service from the receiving Division.

A student will not be eligible for this allowance if he/she takes up permanent residence out of the Division at any time during the school year.

B) Programs Not Offered in a Student's Catchment School

In lieu of school bus transportation, a student who is resident in the Rolling River School Division and who is approved to enroll and attend school in another catchment area within the Rolling River School Division, because he/she is enrolled in a program of study that is not offered in his/her resident catchment area, may be paid a mileage allowance equivalent to the annual transportation grant paid by Manitoba Education.

The allowance will be pro-rated to a monthly fee to be paid on a monthly basis subject to the following conditions:

- the student continues to reside in the Rolling River School Division
- the program of study that the student is attending is not offered in his/her resident catchment area school and
- the student attends over 50% of the recognized program courses each month.

The student may use the allowance to offset costs of transportation to the out-of-catchment area school or, to meet a bus with available space, on an existing route, which will transport him/her to the out-of-catchment area school to be attended.
