## **Basic French Programming**

Where feasible and practical, the provincial curriculum for Basic French will be taught to students at the Grades 4 to 8 levels.

The Basic French Program will be compulsory for all students with the exception of those who have demonstrated significant academic shortcomings and who can be reasonably accommodated in another learning situation. A student will only be considered for this accommodation after consultation with teacher, parents, administration and appropriate support staff.

Erickson Elementary School and Erickson Collegiate Institute students will have the option to select either French or Saulteaux.

## **Exposure French Program**

The K to 1 Exposure Program will be optional and integrated as an enrichment activity. Students will be required to participate in the Grade 2 to 3 Exposure Program.
