1. Student dress code will be determined at the school level by a committee of representative students, parents, staff and school administration and will be reviewed annually.
2. School Dress Codes will be respectful of cultural and religious beliefs.
3. Where applicable, School Dress Codes will be respectful of medical conditions and needs.
4. The following is inappropriate in a school setting:
  - Clothing that is revealing, suggestive or vulgar in nature;
  - Clothing that promotes alcohol, tobacco, drugs and / or violence, including gang related paraphernalia or colours.
