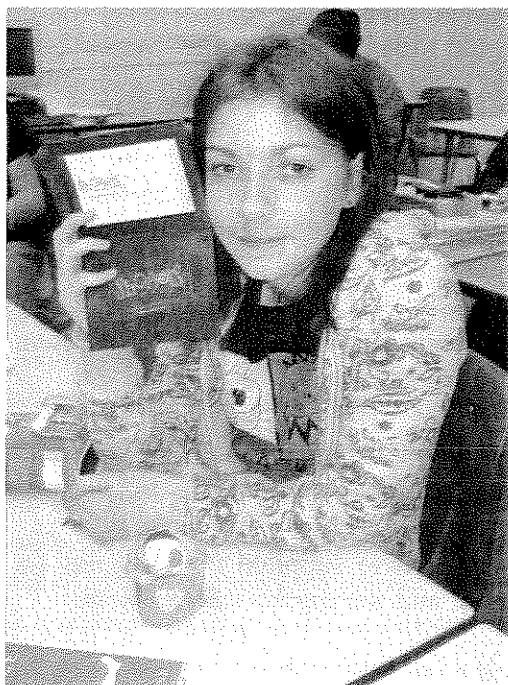

Magazine Sales Successful once again



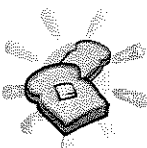

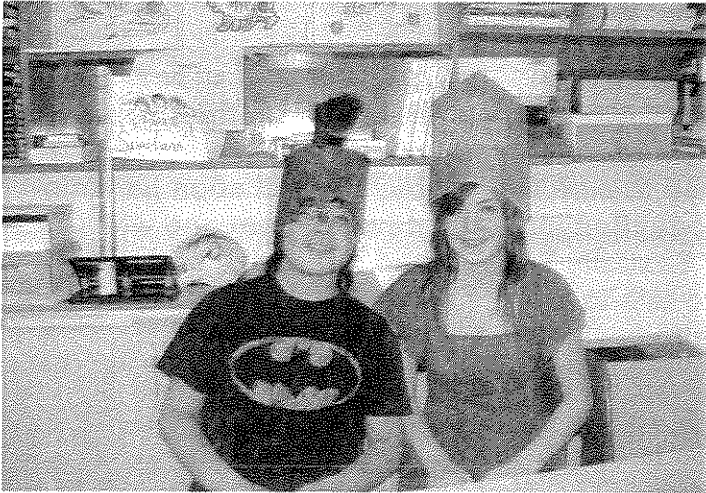
Congratulations are also in order to Brianna Workman who has been invited to play goal for the University of Saskatchewan Huskies next year. Way to go!

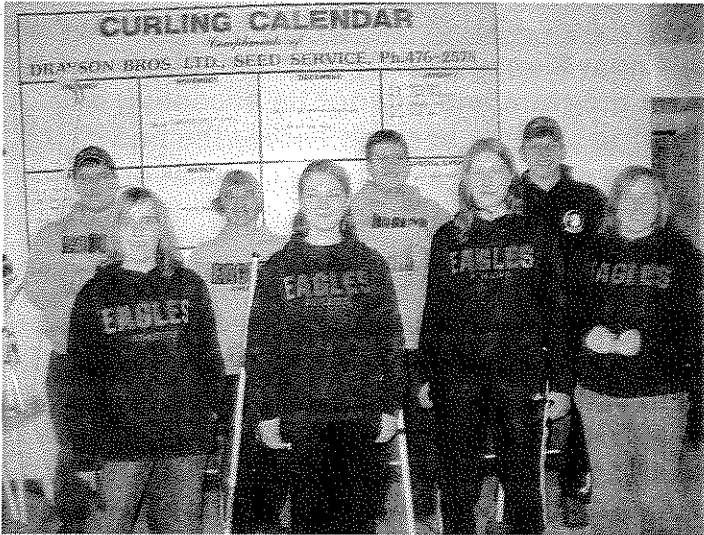
