

# Community Year End Report 2008 – 2009 School Year

## School Priorities

### **1. Communication with parents and Community**

- Bi-weekly newsletters are distributed to community stores and placed on RRSD web page
- Second newsletter of the month contains student's work or articles created by students
- Positive phone calls and notes in planners have increased
- Parent Teacher interviews were well attended, attempts to reschedule were made for those unable to attend – phone interviews also occurred
- Student handbooks continued to be used for communication between home and school

### **2. 100% of students will receive programs to assist with creating a safe, positive learning environment**

- Threat assessment protocol utilized as required
- Safety programs were delivered
- Programs delivered to classes and in small group settings as appropriate
- School Pride initiative completed

### **3. Promote a healthy active lifestyle to 100% of students**

- snacks were monitored
- intra-murals continued for grade 4 – 6 students and physically active games taught to all
- Open House included information of nutrition
- Microwaves removed
- Hot lunches were incorporated into the canteen
