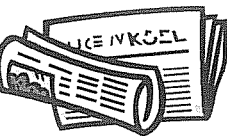

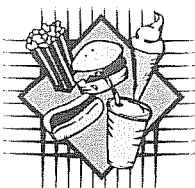


MONTHLY BOOK ORDERS

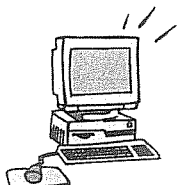
HOT LUNCHES
